AVAIRE™ CLOSSES GAP IN NORTHERN US; MOVES INTO CANADA

With the addition of four new distributors, the Avaire porcelain tile system is now available across the entire northern tier of the United States as well as Canada.

It also serves as built-in underlayment, and the tabs provide precise spacing for trouble-free, same-day grouting.

“Because the flooring industry is moving toward floating floors, more retailers are turning to Avaire,” says Tarver. “As the only floating tile system on the market, it has tremendous appeal for distributors, installers and end users alike.”
